- 3. Head southwest to **Hama** –famous for its waterwheels. Draw a waterwheel icon.
- 4. Now go southeast to **Palmyra** the city of dates. Draw a dates icon.
- 5. From here, travel southwest to the village of **Maaloula** home to Syria's oldest church. Draw a *village* icon.
